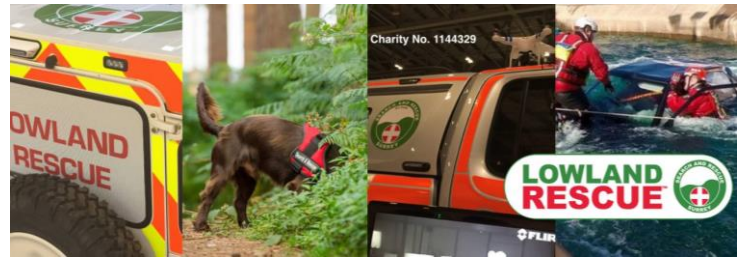

Andrew Duncan Activity Centre – New Planning Application 2018/0312

Scouts in Molesey are working with Surrey's leading lifesaving charity to build a community water activity centre and training facility for Surrey Search & Rescue at Hurst Park.

The previous planning application was withdrawn to allow us time to evaluate questions raised by the Environment Agency, with a view to submitting a greatly improved scheme that everybody can get behind.



We are pleased to inform you that the new planning application (2018/0312) is now live.

Consultation with the Environment Agency has led to a scheme that:

- Has no impact on the flood-plain
- Adds to and extends the biodiversity of Hurst Park
- Is aesthetically pleasing and sensitive to the environment - eco-friendly green roof
- Has reduced the overall size and height of the building

It's so important that young people in our riverside community are given the opportunity to experience the river and learn about water safety.

The activity centre provides Surrey Search & Rescue with training facilities that are essential for them to continue their lifesaving work across Surrey and together we are establishing a programme of water safety awareness for young people in Molesey.

Just some of the benefits to be provided:

- A dedicated training facility for Surrey Search & Rescue and secure storage for their rescue equipment, ensuring they can continue their lifesaving work across Surrey.
- Increased opportunities for young people in Molesey to get outdoors and experience the river in a safe and friendly environment.
- Fully accessible and open to all - activities for those with disabilities and additional needs.
- Stronger emphasis on the education of water safety is required in Elmbridge, we are establishing a programme of water safety awareness in partnership with SurSAR.
- Improvements to flood resilience and biodiversity of Hurst Park.
- Aesthetically pleasing and sensitive to the environment - eco-friendly green roof.
- Natural England has confirmed that the development is not likely to significantly affect interest features for which they are notified.
- The scheme is sound in arboricultural terms and the long term well-being of the retained trees can be safeguarded in a sustainable manner.
- Surrey Wildlife Trust surveyed the site three times – all recommendations are included.
- The activity centre will create a legacy in PC Andrew Duncan's memory and will reflect his dedication to the community through Scouting and his passion for the water.
- An outstanding piece of community infrastructure.
- By creating a culture of curiosity and acceptance in young people, Scouting strengthens communities and contributes to greater social cohesion.
